RE: ASA Code Article 501 B Clarification

We have reviewed ASA Code Article 501 B on the Team Registration issue and are providing the following clarification.

The Code Article Exception was approved for the 2007 ASA Code; the item is listed in the ASA Code as such:

- B. **Team Registration.** A team must register with the local association in which the greatest number of its' players reside.

EXCEPTION: Teams in adjoining counties to a metro association may register in either the state or the metro association.

The following is the Code item split up with clarifications:

Team Registration. A team must register with the local association in which the greatest number of its' players reside.

If the majority of the players on a team reside within the metro association, the team must register as a metro association team.

If the majority of the players on a team reside within the state association and non adjoining areas of the metro association they must register as a state association team.

EXCEPTION: Teams in adjoining counties to a metro association may register in either the state or the metro association.

If the majority of the players on a team reside in the counties adjoining to a metro association; then the team has the option of registering as a state association team or as a metro association team.
